

## LEARNING LAB OPTIONS:

### Supportive Services

\$440 per year / \$44 per month

The Learning Lab Coordinator will serve as a liaison for the family and school by providing teachers with the student's developed Accommodation/Modification Plan along with monitoring the student's academic progress. In addition, testing accommodations in the Learning Lab will be available to middle/high school students.

### Directed Services

\$880 per year / \$88 per month

The student will have regular one-on-one or small group interaction with a Learning Lab instructor through the Learning Lab twice a week, in addition to the supportive services listed above. Sessions will reinforce academic skills being taught in the classroom.

### Search & Teach

\$1,428 per year / \$142.80 per month

Search & Teach is an early intervention program designed to identify and meet the needs of young students before they experience failure in the classroom. A Search & Teach instructor will screen referred individual K5 and 1st grade students for vulnerabilities for learning difficulties and, when determined as necessary, will develop an individualized plan to strengthen any indicated cognitive and perceptual weaknesses. The student will have regular one-on-one interaction with the Search & Teach instructor three 30 minute sessions per week. A \$25 screening fee will be assessed.

### Educational Therapy 1

\$2,855 per year / \$285.50 per month

Educational Therapy is designed to strengthen individual weaknesses in auditory or visual perception, basic academic skills and/or cognition. An educational therapist will design individualized therapy sessions for qualified students in order to stimulate cognitive functioning. The student will have regular one-on-one interaction with the educational therapist for two 75-minute (elementary students) or three 52-minute (MS/HS students) sessions weekly. Initial testing at an additional cost of approximately \$400-500 through a private tester will be required before acceptance into the program.

## **Educational Therapy 2**

\$1,428 per year / \$142.80 per month

Educational Therapy is designed to strengthen individual weaknesses in auditory or visual perception, basic academic skills, and/or cognition. The educational therapist will design individualized therapy sessions for qualified students in order to stimulate cognitive functioning. The student will have regular one-on-one interaction with the educational therapist for two 45-minute sessions weekly. Initial testing at an additional cost of approximately \$400-500 through a private tester will be required before acceptance into the program.
