



# New Student Enrollment Information

## K5 – High School

Life Way Christian School (LWCS) follows a non-discriminatory admissions policy.

As an educational arm of First Baptist Church Centerton, the school maintains the right to deny admission to any student/family whose religious beliefs are not compatible with those as stated in the Statement of Faith.

Students are admitted upon recommendation of the division principal and the school administrator. The School Board of LWCS shall enter into a contract with the parents or guardian of the student. The contracts will be signed by the parents or guardian of the student, the chairman of the School Board and the Headmaster.

The following general policies and procedures will be followed by each division of the school, with the exception of the preschool (3 and 4 year old programs), which will be defined later.

### 1. Admission policies:

- a. LWCS is committed to entering into a partnership with the home to provide support in the education of enrolled students therefore; one parent (guardian) must give evidence of a Christian testimony.  
(Required for all families of K5-high school students)
- b. Students who seek admission in grades 6-12 must give evidence of a Christian testimony
- c. Students who have been “expelled” from another school will not be considered for enrollment at LWCS
- d. Students who have a negative discipline record or who have been suspended from the school they attended prior to applying at LWCS, will be considered for enrollment only after verification of full correction of the problem(s) noted.
- e. All new students are accepted on a probationary basis for the first full grading period of the semester in which they are enrolled.
- f. Tuition assistance is available only to those families who demonstrate a verifiable financial need. Tuition assistance is available first to returning families and then if available to new enrolling families. LWCS does not provide scholarship assistance of any type.

2. Admissions procedures:

  - c. A completed physical form, immunization record, and report card and discipline record from previous school must be on file before full enrollment can occur.
