

Life Way Christian School will provide the opportunity for currently enrolled families, whose children qualify to remain in LWCS for another school year, to be “guaranteed” a place in the grade desired for the next year. The following procedures must be adhered to for this “guarantee” to be in effect:

1. All required paper work or electronic transfer of information and registration fees must be submitted within the time allowed for re-enrollment.

Currently enrolled students whose families do not choose to enroll during the set re-enrollment period will not be guaranteed a place in the school for the next school year.

2. Families who desire to enroll a sibling of a currently enrolled student.
 - a. The family must go to the website and fill out a “New Student Inquiry” form. Once the inquiry is received, the family will be contacted by the appropriate division to set up an appointment.
 - b. This appointment must take place at least one month prior to re-enrollment.
 - c. If the student is in grades 6-12, they must join the parent for the interview appointment with the MS/HS Principal prior to enrollment.
 - d. If the student qualifies for enrollment in LWCS they will be placed at the top of the waiting list, in order of the date of acceptance.
 - e. As space permits, siblings of currently enrolled students will be allowed to enroll on the fourth day of re-enrollment if they have submitted the required paper work, paid fees and had the required interview.

In the event that a space is not available by the time school officially opens for the new school year the registration fee of the sibling will be returned.

3. Families who are planning to re-enroll their PK4 child in the K5 program of LWCS must schedule an appointment with the Elementary Principal prior to the re-enrollment process.

4. Active First Baptist Church Centerton (FBCC) families who desire admission to LWCS may take advantage of the re-enrollment period by being able to submit their “New Student Inquiry” and registration fee on the last day of re-enrollment.
 - a. Active FBCC families who plan to seek enrollment during the re-enrollment period must schedule and complete the interview process prior to the beginning of re-enrollment
 - b. Active FBCC families who apply for a grade that is full will be placed on a waiting list. If the school cannot offer admission by the beginning of the school year the entire registration fee will be refunded.

5. General Guidelines
 - a. Other than individuals who have gone through the enrollment process and cannot be offered a place in the school due to size of the desired class, no registration fees are refundable.
